As you know, March is an extremely busy month in our office. All company fleets of vehicles, all farms plates, RV's, semi-trucks, trailers, not to mention all regular March renewals are done in this month. The goal is to make it easier on you to renew and hopefully address the long lines we have in March.

To accomplish this, we would like to encourage you to come in early or contact the Dealer – Fleet dept at 685-8434 ext 2 to sign-in your business. We will check your paperwork to see if we need anything else (2290's) and will complete your renewals at an agreed upon date (we really need this date to be before March 29<sup>th</sup>). We have been notified by the state that you must make an appointment for your 2290. They no longer will do this without an appointment. . You can contact them for an appointment at 844-545-5640. This will keep you from standing in line and help the process go smoother. Also any customer with 10 or more renewals will be required to sign-in their business so it will be a benefit to you to drop-off your renewals early and set your date for pick-up. After we have processed your business, someone from our office will call and let you know your amount.

We know that times are tough and in hopes of giving you some additional assistance, we will, if it will help you, split your fleets up. You can bring in part of your business at one time and the rest by the end of March. (We can renew some of your business in February if that will assist you, instead of getting hit with one lump sum.)

We hope that this becomes a productive service for you and helps us to serve all our customers better.
