Daviess County Gun Club

The Daviess County Gun Club, owned and operated by Daviess County Fiscal Court, is located at 7740 KY-2830, Maceo, KY 42355. Facilities are operated from March 1—December 15 annually (contingent upon weather conditions).

This 75 acre property is dedicated to the continuation of organized shooting sports and to provide a safe facility for participants.

These facilities, including an 1800 sq. ft. climate controlled clubhouse, are available to the general public for the purposes of shooting sporting clays and trap with future plans including skeet, 3D archery along with and archery and pistol ranges.

Sporting Clays

Sporting clays is a form of clay pigeon shooting, often described as "golf with a shotgun" because a typical course includes from 10 to 12 different shooting stations laid out over natural terrain. For safety, the course size is often no smaller than 35 acres.

Unlike trap and skeet, which are games of repeatable target presentations, sporting clays simulates the unpredictability of live-quarry shooting with regular course changes offering a great variety of trajectories, angles, speeds, elevations, distances, and target sizes.

Trap

Trap is played by shooting five shots from five stations (25 targets) located 16-27 yards behind a trap house. A trap target is thrown at an unknown angle from the house. Targets are released by a wireless voice activated system.

Skeet

Skeet is played with two machines, one in a low house and one in a high house (the designation of high and low relates to the location of the machine in relation to the ground). The openings of the houses face each other, and the targets are thrown with no side-to-side or up and down variation.



DIRECTIONS:
