The meeting opened in Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

By a motion of Commissioner Koger, seconded by Commissioner Wathen, the court considered for approval; Minutes of the June 16, 2022 Court Meeting.

By a motion of Commissioner Castlen, seconded by Commissioner Koger, the court considered for approval; All Claims for All Departments.

By a motion of Commissioner Koger, seconded by Commissioner Castlen, the court considered for approval; Budget Transfers for FY Ending June 30, 2022.

Assistant County Treasurer Jordan Johnson: This is the third and final round of this fiscal year's budget transfers, all of which are either offset by revenue, another expense reduction, or an item or project approved by the court. I request your approval to transfer \$76,900 in the General Fund, \$2,000 in the Road Fund, \$18,600 in the Jail Fund, and \$800 in the Solid Waste Fund.

Judge Mattingly: We do this annually to true up the books.

The vote was called and with all present members voting in favor, said motion passed.

No Other Business was brought before the Daviess County Fiscal Court.
