Responsible Server Training

Dear Owner/Operator/Management:

As per Title XI, Chapter 110 Section 110.2 (G) of the Daviess County Code of Ordinances, all those licensed by the county to sell alcoholic beverages shall require all of their employees who are engaged in the selling or serving of alcoholic beverages, and the manager(s) of premises, to complete a Responsible Beverage Service Training class. This requirement was passed by the Daviess County Fiscal Court on June 1st, 2017.

To comply with enforcement, each year at renewal you are required to submit to the County a report containing an alphabetical listing of your alcohol-trained employees and manager(s), the date in which the training was completed, the date the training expires, and which training class they completed.

You are to complete the enclosed form and return it to David Smith at the address, email or fax indicated above within 90 days of receiving your license.

The filing of this report is mandatory and the condition of your license to sell alcoholic beverages. Your cooperation and timely submission is appreciated. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me at (270) 685-8424.
