4. Adjournment

In accordance with the provisions of KRS 67.045 and KRS Chapter 424, notice is given that the fiscal court plans to reapportion the boundary lines for the three Fiscal Court Commissioners, three Justices of the Peace, and three Constables. Boundary lines shall be laid off so that the districts are compact, contiguous, and the population of each district shall be as nearly equal as is reasonably possible. The fiscal court shall appoint three citizens as commissioners to reapportion the county into three (3) districts. The first meeting of the Reapportionment Committee is **June 8, 2023, at 5:00 p.m. in the Daviess County Fiscal Court, Courtroom. A written report of such boundary lines shall be filed with the Daviess Fiscal Court and the Office of the County Clerk within 60 days of appointment of commissioners. Within 60 days of receipt of the report establishing the three districts, the fiscal court shall adopt or amend the report. As soon as the fiscal court adopts the report, any Daviess County registered voter may bring an action in Circuit Court to enforce the provisions of KRS 67.045. Any action brought to Circuit Court must be done within 20 days from fiscal court's adoption of said report. Circuit Court shall hear the action and, on a finding that provisions of KRS 67.045 have been violated, remand the matter to fiscal court.*
